

Oakland School for the Arts (OSA) is a dynamic, thriving, diverse charter school in an urban environment that serves approximately 800 students in grades 6-12. We are seeking a part-time (.8) Mental Health Therapist, who will provide Student Support Services, to join our outstanding staff.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provide on-site counseling to students, including individual, group, and crisis counseling.
- Serve as liaison between school, scholar, home and community mental health and community referrals, linkages, and collaborations with the school and community resources to address student and family needs.
- Participate in multidisciplinary teams, including: Coordination of Services Team (COST), Student Support Team (SST), and other activities.
- Collaborate with teachers and school staff providing mental health consultation to develop strategies for classroom management, designing and monitoring behavior contracts, and positive behavior support planning and implementation.
- Collaborate with other members of Student Support Team to conducts staff development to address barriers to learning and restore and maintain a safe and healthy learning environment for students, staff, and parents, including: Impact of Trauma and Learning, Psychological First Aid, Crisis Intervention, Threat Assessment and Management, and Suicide Prevention Services.
- Provide parent education programs.

- Masters Degree or higher in counseling, psychology, clinical social work, or a closely related field.
- California licensure in Marriage and Family Therapy, Social Work, or Psychology.
- PPS Credential in School Counseling (preferred)
- At Least one year of experience (2+ years preferred) providing mental health services in school-based settings
- Strong organizational skills as demonstrated by the ability to effectively manage multiple tasks
- Ability to be flexible and adaptive in a dynamic work environment
